Our program is completely free for both Littles and Bigs.

Safety is our number one priority and all mentors are thoroughly screened through interviews, reference checks, background checks, and fingerprints.



TAILOR-MADE

Our Matches are not just first come first served.

They are intentionally matched by our Enrollment Team. We match Bigs and Littles based on many factors, including personality, hobbies, interests, location, experiences, goals, and more. We also make sure that all parties are in agreement of the match going forward..

PROFESSIONALLY SUPPORTED

Once matched Big and Littles are assigned a "Match Support Specialist" that will support them for the duration of their match. The Match Support Specialist will be contact with the Little, Parent/Guardian, and Big on a regular basis and make sure things are going well. Match Support Specialists will give you activity ideas, encouragement, troubleshoot nuances, and be there for your match!

MATCH ACTIVITIES

BBBS hosts Match Activities every few months to provide some fun for our matches and also give them opportunities to connect with other Bigs and Littles. We do many different things from roller skating to rafting to parties in the park.



COMMUNITY-BASED MENTORING

This program allows Bigs and Littles to create a friendship by participating in low to no cost activities in our community. Bigs and Littles meet two to three times a month. Bigs and Parent/Guardians coordinate outings.

Together you do things in the community like visit a park, attend community events, cook, do arts and crafts or sports, hike, play board games, or just talk.



SCHOOL-SITE MENTORING

This program allows Bigs and Littles to create a friendship by meeting once a week at the Little's school during their lunch period. Eat lunch together and then do a fun activity!
