FOOD PANTRIES

- Salvation Army - Boise Corps – Qualified families and individuals can visit once every 30 days. 9492 Emerald Street Boise, ID 83704

UTILITY ASSISTANCE

- Emergency Water Utility Assistance - El-Ada Community Action Partnership - The Emergency Water Utility Assistance program provides assistance once per year for United Water, Meridian Water, or Boise City Utility Billing customers who are facing shut-off. Call: (208) 345-2820
- Winter Energy Assistance - El-Ada Community Action Partnership - This program provides assistance for a household's main heating source. LIHEAP pays a one-time, set benefit amount directly to the utility company.
- Salvation Army Energy Assistance - Project Share - Provides assistance directly to energy providers one time per year. Funding for the program is given by Idaho Power and Intermountain Gas and their customers who donate directly to Project Share. Call: (208) 433-4424

EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE

- Housing Subsidization Program - Catholic Charities of Idaho (CCI) – Seniors and single parent households. Eligible applicants will receive up to one year of direct financial assistance, while receiving comprehensive case management services to decrease household costs and increase access to resources and other community supports. - Jesse Tree of Idaho – Emergency Rental Assistance - provides financial assistance coupled with case management to stabilize low-income renters at risk of eviction and homelessness. Call: (208) 383-9486

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ASSISTANCE

- Secure Shelter & Transitional Living – Women's and Children's Alliance - The Women's & Children's Alliance (WCA) provides a comprehensive and secure 120-day residential shelter program and transitional housing.
- Crisis Intervention Resources – Faces of Hope - Faces of Hope is a warm and welcoming place, where people affected by interpersonal violence can come and receive help.
